

OFF-LICENCE

Sections 17 to 20, 59 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

PURSUANT to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act), **Lauregan Properties Limited** (the licensee) is authorised to sell alcohol on the premises situated at 2069 Kahuranaki Road and known as "Lauregan Wines", to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises. If this licence is not endorsed under Section 40 of the Act, the licensee is also authorised to sell alcohol on or from the premises and deliver it somewhere else.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- (a) No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Good Friday, Christmas Day, or before 1pm on Anzac Day.
- (b) No alcohol can be delivered to a buyer or someone on the buyer's behalf at any time after 11pm on any day and before 6am on the next day.
- (c) No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Easter Sunday unless the alcohol is grape wine or fruit or vegetable wine made:
 - (i) on the premises; or
 - (ii) from grapes or fruit harvested from land on which the premises are situated.
- (d) Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:
Monday to Sunday 9.00am to 5.00pm
- (e) Order forms shall require customers to declare that they are over 18 years of age or older.
- (f) The licensee must ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale and supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed and must display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.

THE LICENSED PREMISES

The sale or delivery of alcohol is authorised in or from the Cellar Door. The premises, situated at 2069 Kahuranaki Road, Havelock North, are more precisely identified as outlined in a plan date stamped as received by the Central Hawke's Bay District Licensing Agency on 29 April 2014.

DISPLAY OF LICENCE AND PRINCIPAL ENTRANCE/S

A copy of this licence must be displayed at the principal entrance to the premises. The entrance from Kahuranaki Road is designated as the principal entrance. A Digital copy of this licence must be displayed on the website.

DURATION

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force:

- (i) Until the close of the period of 1 year commencing with the date of its issue; or
- (ii) If an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made, until the application is determined; or
- (iii) If the licence is renewed, until the close of the period for which it was renewed.
